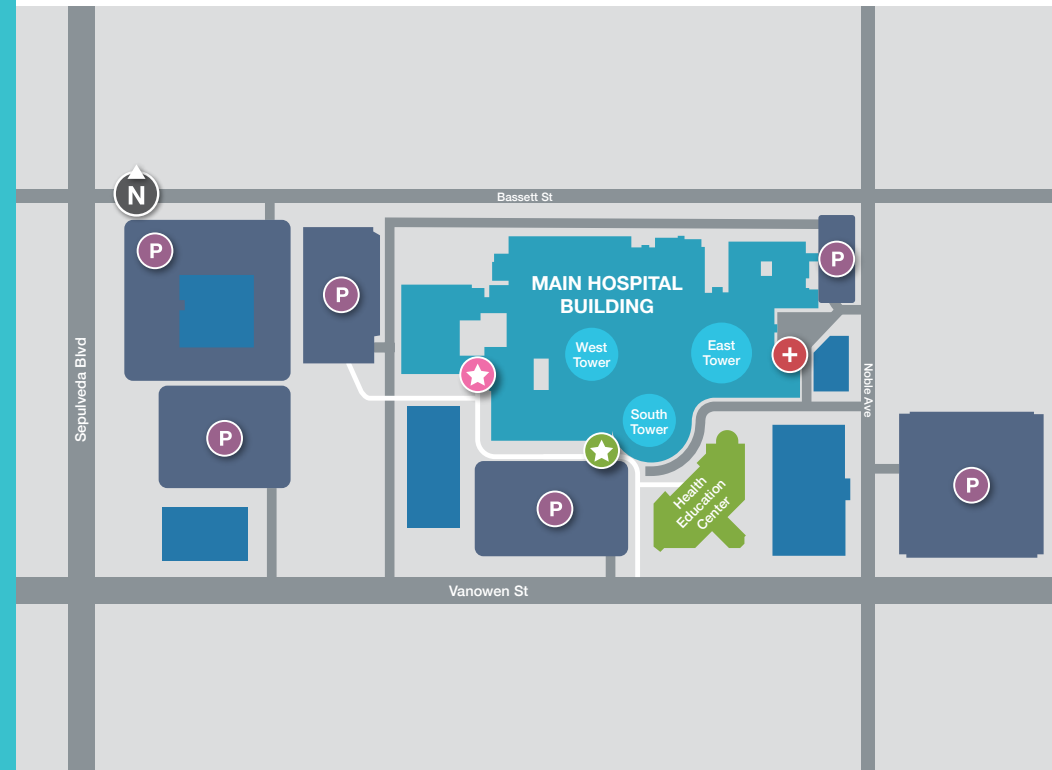

### Juan Pelayo, MD

Dr. Pelayo is a board certified pediatric surgeon at Children's Hospital Los Angeles and an Assistant Professor Surgery of at the Keck School of Medicine of the University of Southern California. Dr. Pelayo grew up in the San Fernando Valley where he attended local schools and earned his bachelor's degree in Molecular Biology from California State University of Northridge. He earned his medical degree and general surgery training from the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). He completed his pediatric surgery fellowship at the University of Chicago Medical Center Comer Children's Hospital. Dr. Pelayo specializes in providing care of infants, children and adolescents. He has broad expertise in general pediatric surgery including management of inguinal hernias, hydroceles and undescended testes. His main clinical interests are in minimally invasive surgery of the chest and abdomen. He has experience with pediatric cancers, including the evaluation and treatment of head and neck masses. He now serves as the Director of Pediatric Surgery for Providence Tarzana Medical Center and Valley Presbyterian Hospital. He sits in committees to improve patient safety, enhance quality of care, and evaluate clinical outcomes.



### Lauralie Johnson, MSN, RN, ACNP-BC

Lauralie Johnson is an Acute Care Nurse Practitioner who has been working with San Gabriel Valley Medical Center SART performing forensic exams for patients across the lifespan from pediatrics to geriatrics since 2014. She completed her training in forensic examination through the California Clinical Forensic Medical Training Center in conjunction with the CA District Attorney's office for both pediatrics and adults. As part of her graduate work at CSULA she completed a research project entitled "Education on the Management of Sexual Assault Victims for Emergency Department Nurses: Increasing Nursing Knowledge and Decreasing Rape Myth Acceptance". When not working at SGVMC SART, she practices in the Emergency Departments at both Hollywood Presbyterian Medical Center and Garfield Medical Center.



### Clyde Wesp, MD

Dr. Wesp joined Valley Presbyterian Hospital as Senior Vice President-Chief Medical Officer at Valley Presbyterian Hospital in February 2018. Dr. Wesp leads the organization in quality, performance improvement, and medical staff. Prior to joining Valley Presbyterian, Dr. Wesp has served as the Chief Health Information Officer, Chief Medical Officer and Chief Medical Information Officer at organizations across the country and in California.
